Workshop Fee

If you have not been invited to participate or to give a talk, a fee is payable to attend the Workshop in order to help cover your costs. There is a choice of two packages:

- **Day Delegate at £125.00**, which covers coffee/tea and buffet lunches at Worcester College
- **Day and Evening Delegate at £225.00** which covers coffee/tea, buffet lunches, pre-dinner drinks and dinners at Worcester College.
